

Contribution regulations of the association GARP e.V. (hereinafter referred to as Association)

§ 1 Basic principle

These contribution regulations are not part of the articles of association. They regulate the contribution obligations of the members as well as the fees and levies. They can only be amended by the association's general meeting.

§ 2 Resolutions

1. The general meeting decides on the amount of the contribution and any necessary levies. The Executive Board determines the contributions.
2. The fixed contributions shall be levied from the month following the month in which the resolution was passed. A different date can also be set by resolution of the General Meeting.

§ 3 Membership fees

The Association's Board of Directors must be informed immediately of any changes to membership details.

Members shall pay their contributions to the association's contribution account by January 31 of each year at the latest or immediately after joining the association in the current calendar year.

Reminder fees of EUR 25.00 per reminder will be charged for reminders.

If you join the association by June 30 of a given year, you must pay the full membership fee; from July 1 of a given year, you must pay half the membership fee.

Withdrawal from the association is only possible in accordance with § 3 of the Articles of Association.

§ 4 Separate fees

Separate fees may be charged for any additional services provided by the Association, which are to be determined in detail by the Executive Board.

§ 5 Data processing

Contributions, fees and levies are collected by means of data processing (EDP). Members' personal data is stored in accordance with the Federal Data Protection Act.
